

Admission test to the first year of the bachelor degree in Information and Communication (ISIC), Rabat

Academic year 2024/2025

The admission test to the first year of the bachelor degree at the Higher Institute of Information and Communication (ISIC) for the academic year 2024/2025 will take place on Sunday September 8, 2024, at 8:30 a.m. at the ISIC (Madinat Al Irfane, Rabat).

+ Admission process :

To be admitted to ISIC, candidates must:

- Meet the preselection criteria;
- Pass the written and oral tests of the competition.

+ The preselection:

The pre-selection of the applications, admitted to the written test, is supervised by the admission test commission.

+ Preselection eligibility:

To be admitted to ISIC, candidates must:

- Hold a high school degree of 2023 or 2024, all specialties or any other diploma recognized as equivalent to the high school degree.
- Be at least 17 years old and no more than 25 years old by December 31, 2024.
- Have obtained a general average score of at least 14/20 in the high school degree.
- Have obtained a score of at least 14/20 in Arabic, French and 3rd language in the high school degree score.

+ Admission test registration form:

- To register, candidates must complete the online form (<https://preinscription.isic.ma>).
- Candidates must upload the various supporting documents below:
 - Exams' transcripts, regional, national and the high school degree;
 - A copy of the CNIE (National identity card).
- A file submission number will be assigned to them and sent to their email address.
- Civil servant candidates must:
 - Be under the age of 35 by December 31, 2024.
 - Provide an authorization to pass the admission test, issued by their administration.

Registration deadlines:

- online registration (<https://preinscription.isic.ma>) is open from the date of publication of this notice until July 28, 2024.
- The supporting documents to be uploaded at the bottom of the form must be in PDF or jpeg format and their size must not exceed 3MB.

II - Admission tests

The ISIC entrance exams are held in three languages: Arabic, French or English.

The admission test is composed of two parts: written and oral.

1. **The written test:** it concerns the knowledge and culture of the candidates.
2. **The oral test:** Candidates undergo an interview in front of a jury made up of ISIC professors. The jury tests the expression and communication skills of the candidates as well as their willingness to join the institute .

NB:

- **It is up to the admission test commission to take the appropriate decisions determining the admission process.**
- **The education at ISIC is organized into three sections: Arabic-speaking, French-speaking and English-speaking.**
- **The academic system of education in ISIC system is regular.**
